<b>Descripción:</b>	<p><b>Introduction of the Institute and Programs</b></p> <p>The idea that China establishes the Institute of South-South Cooperation and Development (ISSCAD) of Peking University was initiated and announced by Chinese President XI Jinping during the High-Level Roundtable on South-South Cooperation at the 70th Anniversary Celebration of the United Nations in New York on September 26, 2015. The Institute aims to summarize and share the successful experiences of China and other developing countries, integrate theories with practices, build a teaching and research system for national development studies, and cultivate high-level interdisciplinary talents with both theoretical knowledge and practical skills, outstanding leadership, and scientific decision-making capabilities for developing countries. The ultimate goal of the Institute is to support global economic and social development, and promote the realization of shared aspirations of solidarity, cooperation, and common development among developing countries. **Información específica:** Our three-year Doctoral Program in National Development Studies is designed to cultivate high-caliber talents and national leaders who are equipped with a solid theoretical foundation and global perspective, acquainted with China's development experience, and capable of making decisions and policies related to national development with real-world conditions of his/her own country taken into consideration. Candidates must demonstrate a proven record of high academic and professional accomplishments, and a desire to further hone their leadership skills and elevate their knowledge on national development. Prospective doctoral candidates must hold a master's degree and have at least five years of work experience in government agencies or relevant organizations. Candidates who have completed the systematic coursework, earned a total 27 credits (including a course on Chinese language), conducted research under the guidance of an academic supervisor, successfully completed a dissertation with both academic and practical values, and passed the oral defense, will be awarded a doctoral degree conferred by Peking University.

The Doctoral Program in National Development Studies seeks to cultivate high-caliber composite talents for developing countries who are committed to promoting their own country's development, the global development agenda agenda, and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. They should possess specialized knowledge and expertise, master the theory of National Development Studies, and understand how to apply this theoretical knowledge

to the formulation of domestic development policies and international development cooperation practice. They should also possess independent research capabilities, outstanding leadership, and scientific decision-making abilities.

Our one-year Master Program in Public Administration (National Development) is an economics-centered multidisciplinary program that combines rigorous analytical work with an emphasis on public policy and leadership. It is designed for mid-career candidates with a record of academic distinction and exceptional professional accomplishment and promise. Candidates for this program are expected to have obtained a bachelor's degree or above in a relevant field and at least three years of substantial work experience, typically in government or public sector. Through a structured study program of 1 year, students should earn a total of 40 credits (including a course on Chinese language), successfully complete a thesis under the guidance of an academic supervisor, pass the oral defense, and finally be awarded a master's degree conferred by Peking University.

The training objective of the Master's program in Public Administration (National Development) is to cultivate high-end and versatile international talents with comprehensive theoretical knowledge, broad international perspectives, open and scientific thinking and the ability to integrate theory with practice, who are dedicated to the cause of national development, serving in areas such as public affairs, public administration, public policy, and global governance.

**Información específica:** **Program Objective**

This program is open to fresh university graduates as well as the experienced professionals and the government officials from different countries, and is designed to train those students in the field of public affairs, public

administration, and public policy.

Students are expected to complete the program full time over 1 year.

The program aims to

- provide students with an opportunity to develop functional expertise, strategic perspectives, and public policy management tools that they require to operate effectively in a changing public policy environment or to understand such an environment.
- help students to learn both the successes and failures in China's public policy making and management, and therefore to understand more about how to manage political, economic and social development in developing countries.
- introduce students the techniques of policy analysis and program evaluation to resolve complex multi-dimensional policy challenges, as well as sharpen their leadership and communication skills.

#### **Enrollment Plan In 2026**

Entry we have planned to enroll up to 30 students in our master program in major of Public Policy.

<b>Observaciones:</b>	<p>Financial Aid</p> <p>The Chinese Ministry of Commerce will provide "Chinese Government Scholarships" to admitted students from developing countries.</p> <p>1These scholarships cover expenses on their studies and basic life, and round-trip international airfare. The students don't have to pay for the tuition fee, books fee, field trip fee, English-taught assistant fee and tutor's fee.</p> <p>2The University will arrange the dormitory.</p> <p>3The University will transfer the living allowance by month based on the actual duration of students' stay in China. It is 36000RMB/year for the master program.</p> <p>4There is also a settlement allowance of 3000RMB/person.</p>

5The University will buy insurance for all students.

6They also include a round-trip international airfare for all the students, and one time for 1y Program.

7All other fees will be arranged by the Ministry or University or University, the students cannot get any more scholarship if cannot graduate and get degree on time. No more scholarship will be given if students defer the study for any reason.

#### Requirement

1) Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens from developing countries, with a valid passport, or any other identification certificate sufficient to verify his/her nationality; Applicant should not more than 45 years old (born after September 1, 1981);

2) All applicants shall be in good physical conditions (They do not have serious hypertension, cardiovascular and cerebrovascular diseases, diabetes, cancer and so on), and carry no infectious diseases which may have a serious impact on public health or fall into any of the health situations prohibited by China's Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Laws and Regulations. They are not in a major recovery period; there is no acute exacerbation, no serious physical disability, not in pregnancy; if someone get pregnant during the studyshe needs to drop the program;

3) Applicants for the master program must have attained a Bachelor degree or above;

4) The applicants who have a professional learning or work background related to the project being applied and have priority in the incumbent;

5Serve as a middle-level public official in the government of their country, or as a senior manager of various institutions and enterprises, as well as academic staff of universities and research institutions;

6) Applicants must be proficient in English. Non-native English speakers or candidates whose undergraduate education was not conducted in English are required to submit a test score of IELTS generally 6.0 or aboveor TOEFLgenerally 80 or aboveor GRE ect. as proof of English proficiency;

7The applicants should have the potential for career development in this field, and intend to promote friendly exchanges and cooperation between the host country and China;

8Registered students who stay in China or have been taken by other Chinese government scholarships may not apply; Applicants of special status categories need to be reviewed in process.

9) Only applicants recommended by the Economic and Commercial Counsellor's Office of Chinese Embassy in the country that accords with the candidate's nationality will be considered.
